

Announcement of Forest Industry Organization Subject : Policy of not accepting neither gifts nor profits from performing duties (No Gift Policy) Year 2025

Forest Industry Organization commits to managing organization, in accordance with the principles of good governance. Operate with honesty, integrity, efficiency, transparency, and accountability, in line with the National Reform Plan (revised edition). Prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct the goal is for every government agency to announce that all government officials will not accept gifts, receiving and giving all kinds of gifts and others forms of benefits during/before/after performing duties (No Gift Policy).

Forest Industry Organization shall be an anti-corruption organization and enhance culture values of honesty in working with morality and ethics. There is no conflict of interest from performing duties, and all officials perform their duties with transparency and fairness, "refrain from receiving or giving gifts of any kind" and do not allow family members to receive gifts, property or any other benefits from people who are not relatives. By following the announcement of the prevention committee and the national suppression of corruption, dated February 19, 2020. Regarding the criteria for receiving property or other benefits according to the ethics of government officials and the regulations of the office of the Prime Minister regarding giving or receiving gifts by government officials (2022) strictly.
